### Health Unit Advises Only High Risk Groups Attend H1N1 Vaccination Clinics on October 29 & 30

#### *Clinics for All Residents Begin October 31 at Portage Place*

#### **Wednesday, October 28, 2009, Peterborough**

Due to high demand for the H1N1 vaccine, the Peterborough County-City Health Unit is asking that only those individuals who qualify as high risk to attend the vaccination clinics for priority groups on Thursday, October 29 and Friday, October 30.

Priority groups include:

- Health care workers
- Pregnant women
- People under 65 years with chronic conditions
- Children 6 months to 59 months
- Household contacts and care providers of infants less than 6 months old or those who have compromised immune systems

The PCCHU advises those attending clinics that with the high demand, wait times can be up to a few hours long, so it is a good idea to come prepared with snacks and something to read. To speed up the process, people are also asked to bring an Ontario Health Card and driver's license. Those who do not have these cards will still be vaccinated.

The remaining two clinics **for priority groups only** will take place as follows:
