Appointments Available for Pregnant Women**

*Appointments Available This Week for Pregnant Women Wanting the
Unadjuvanted H1N1 Vaccine*

Monday, November 9, 2009, Peterborough

The Peterborough County-City Health Unit still has clinic appointments available this week for pregnant women who want to be immunized with the unadjuvanted H1N1 vaccine, Panvax®.

Women are asked to call **748-2021** to make an appointment, and are reminded to bring their Ontario health cards and driver's license. There is no charge to receive the vaccine. The Peterborough County-City Health Unit is located at 10 Hospital Drive and free parking is provided.

Pregnant women are at higher risk of hospitalization and complications due to influenza. Immunization against influenza is recommended for all pregnant women by the Society of Obstetricians and Gynecology of Canada.

The adjuvanted vaccine (Arepanrix®) will continue to be available for pregnant women who want it at the regular H1N1 vaccination clinics run by the PCCHU throughout the community.
