Health Unit Cancels H1N1 Vaccination Clinic at Trent University on Nov. 18 and Fleming College on Nov. 19

Priority Groups Still the Focus for Vaccine

Friday, November 13, 2009, Peterborough

The Peterborough County-City Health Unit has cancelled two H1N1 vaccination clinics next week at Trent University and at Fleming College due to the province's continued focus on priority groups for the vaccine.

The cancelled clinics include one planned for Trent University on Wednesday, November 18 from 12 noon to 3 p.m. and another slated for Fleming College on Thursday, November 19 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Another clinic at Trent University scheduled for Thursday, November 26 from 12 noon to 3 p.m. and another one at Fleming College on Friday, November 27 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. are still planned in the hopes that the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care expands access to the H1N1 vaccine by then to the general public so students, staff and community residents can get immunized at local post-secondary institutions.

Clinics continue to operate for priority groups every Monday through Friday until December 2 at Peterborough Square from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and at Portage Place from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday clinics are also available from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on November 14 at both malls, on November 21 at Portage Place, and on November 28 at Peterborough Square.
