Subject: Rabies Clinics  
**Saturday, April 4th, 2009**

All dogs and cats over the age of three (3) months must be immunized against rabies. These same animals must be re-immunized in accordance with the date prescribed in the certificate of immunization issued. This is in an effort to reduce human exposure to the rabies virus.

The Peterborough County-City Health Unit, in co-operation with the local veterinarians, is again sponsoring low-cost rabies clinics in our area for dogs and cats.

The rabies clinics will be held on Saturday, **April 4th, 2009** at all locations listed.
